O P I N I O N

Leo M. Gehring and Mary B. Gehring, doing business as West Coast Van & Storage and Davis Van & Storage, request authority to sell and transfer, and Charles R. Wood, doing business as West Coast Van & Storage, requests authority to purchase and acquire prescriptive authority to operate as a public utility warehouseman at Vacaville, California.

The operative right was described in Decision No. 61695, dated March 21, 1961, in Case No. 6775 and authorizes the storage of household goods and other nonperishable commodities in 3,000 square feet of storage space at Vacaville, and 6,400 square feet of storage space at Davis. The Vacaville space is the subject of the transfer herein considered. Applicant sellers intend to continue operating the Davis warehouse. The agreed consideration is \$10. As of June 30, 1963 applicant purchaser indicated a net worth in the amount of \$3,236.18.

After consideration, the Commission finds that the proposed sale would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary.

The authorization herein granted shall not be construed as a finding of the value of the right herein authorized to be transferred.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. On or before May 1, 1964, Leo M. Gehring and Mary B. Gehring may sell and transfer, and Charles R. Wood may purchase and acquire the prescriptive operating authority as set forth in Appendix B attached hereto and as described in Decision No. 61695, dated March 21, 1961, in Case No. 6775.
2. Within thirty days after the consummation of the transfer herein authorized, Charles R. Wood shall notify the Commission, in writing, of that fact and within said period shall file with the Commission a true copy of any bill of sale or other instrument of transfer which may be executed to effect said transfer.
3. Charles R. Wood shall amend or reissue the tariffs on file with the Commission, naming rates, rules and regulations governing the warehouse operations herein to show that he has adopted or established, as his own, said rates, rules and regulations. The tariff filings shall be made effective not earlier than ten days after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and the public, and the effective date of the tariff filings shall be concurrent with the consummation of the transfer herein authorized. The tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall comply in all respects with the regulations governing the construction and filing of tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 61-A.

4. On or before the end of the third month, after the consummation of the transfer as herein authorized, Charles R. Wood shall cause to be filed with the Commission, in such form as it may prescribe, an annual report, or reports, covering the period commencing with the first day of the current year to and including the effective date of the transfer.

5. Concurrent with the transfer authorized in ordering paragraph 1 hereof Appendix A attached to Decision No. 61695 is hereby amended by incorporating First Revised Page 1 attached hereto in place of Original Page 1.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
