Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to construct an industrial track at grade across Uranium Road in the Cities of Santa Clara and Sunnyvale, Santa Clara County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. E-41.61-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the road now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding three percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) equipped with reflexreflective sheet material. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This
