

that availability of water from the Calleguas Municipal Water District is imminent.

We find that Conejo has sufficient water to serve said gasoline service station without impairing service to Conejo's other customers and that the authorization of such service would not be adverse to the public interest. We conclude that applicant's request should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Conejo Valley Water Company is authorized to furnish water service to the gasoline service station on the west side of Moorpark Road at the intersection of Avenida de Los Arboles, Thousand Oaks, California, and to revise its tariff service area map in accordance with General Order No. 96-A, to reflect the inclusion of the station's premises within its tariff service area.

2. In all other respects the provisions of Decisions Nos. 65916, 64763 and 62474 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.

SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Conejo Valley Water Company^{1/} has requested authority to provide water service to a gasoline service station located on the northwest corner of the intersection of Moorpark Road and Avenida de Los Arboles, Thousand Oaks, California, outside of and across the street from the boundary of the utility's certificated service area and approximately 60 feet from a six-inch water main belonging to Conejo. It appears that the service station is not within the service area of any other water system and that the nearest such system is several thousand feet distant.

By Decision No. 62474, dated August 23, 1961; Decision No. 64763, dated January 8, 1963; and Decision No. 65916, dated August 20, 1963, Conejo is prohibited from accepting applications and furnishing new services outside of its certificated area.

Conejo states that the water supplies now available to it are considerably in excess of present or foreseeable demands, and
