ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By Petition For Modification No. 8 in Case No. 7024, California Farm Bureau Federation, a non-profit corporation, seeks amendment of Distance Table No. 4 to include therein constructive mileages via certain new roads between Los Banos, Stevinson, Turlock and Oakdale which were constructed since Distance Table No. 4 was issued.

In a letter addressed to the Commission dated November 12, 1963 petitioner states that the main purpose of its petition was to solve constructive mileages problems in the movement of hay and that subsequent to the filing of the instant petition Petition for Modification No. 313 in Case No. 5432 was filed by the California Trucking Association seeking the adoption of Distance Table No. 5 to govern the minimum rates for the transportation of hay, fodder and straw set forth in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 14. The letter further states that the roads sought to be included in Distance Table No. 4 are included in Distance Table No. 5 and that adoption of Distance Table No. 5 to govern Minimum Rate Tariff No. 14 would provide substantially the relief sought in Petition No. 8 in Case No. 7024. Petitioner requests that if Petition No. 313 in Case No. 5432 is granted, its Petition No. 8 in Case No. 7024 be dismissed.

Petition No. 313 in Case No. 5432 was granted by Decision No. 66625, dated January 14, 1964.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Petition For Modification No. 8 in Case No. 7024 is hereby dismissed.

The effective date of this order shall be thirty days after the date hereof.
