ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Public hearing in this matter was held before Examiner Emerson on November 20, 1963 at San Francisco. ^{1/}

This application seeks authority to deviate from certain of the provisions of General Order No. 95 so as to permit specialized electric overhead construction on Beverly Avenue, south of Alameda de Las Pulgas, San Carlos.

By Decision No. 66707, issued January 28, 1964 in Application No. 45653, General Order No. 95 was modified in such manner as to permit the herein proposed construction on a statewide basis. Authority to deviate is therefore moot and this application should be dismissed.
