OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 66873, entered today in Case No. 5441, the Commission found that an exception rating of third class, less truckload, should be established in City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A and Minimum Rate Tariff No. 1-B for the transportation of "Ballasts, Fluorescent Lamp, not enclosed in lamp channels or chassis, in boxes."

That decision also found that, in order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution, City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A should be amended by separate order.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A (Appendix "A" of Decision No. 41363, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective April 4, 1964, Eleventh Revised Page 3 and Eighth Revised Page 26, which revised pages are attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. In all other respects said Decision No. 41363, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
