I dissent for the same reasons set forth in the dissenting views in Decision No. 65919 dated August 20, 1963.

Additionally, since the aforesaid decision was issued, the Commission issued Decision No. 66453 dated December 10, 1963, in Case No. 5432, Petitions 233 and 235. In the latter decision the Commission fixed minimum rates based upon cost evidence which was vigorously attacked by certain parties as being insufficient. The Commission found that petitioners' cost studies were the best evidence upon which to adjust the rates for the present and stated that if, upon completion of the staff's cost studies, further adjustments, either up or down, were shown to be necessary, the Commission would undertake to consider such adjustments. Thus, handicapped though it might have been, the Commission nevertheless undertook to discharge its mandatory duties under Section 3662 of the Public Utilities Code. Here, facing a handicap differing only in degree, if at all, the majority chooses the not even tackle the problem.
