In the Matter of the Application of MODESTO INTERURBAN RAILWAY, a corporetion, to construct one standard gauge Application No. 45721 railroad track at grade across State Highway 132, in the County of Stanislaus, State of California.

Modesto Interurban Railway Company is hereby authorized to construct additional spur træckat grade across State Route 110 near Empire. Stanislaus County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 28-5.0-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the road now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two percent. Protection shall be by three Standard No. 8 crossing signals equipped with "TWO TRACKS" sign. (General Order No. 75-B) Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order. applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with.

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Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.
