O R D E R

The County of Marin is hereby authorized to construct Mar West Street at grade across tracks of Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company at Tiburon, Marin County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 5-7.2. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company shall bear maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty-four feet and grades of approach not greater than three percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 crossing signals (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The County desires to immediately commence construction so that Tiburon residents will not be required to travel an extensive detour around a landslide which has blocked the old road.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
