O R D E R

The Western Pacific Railroad Company is hereby authorized to construct a side track at grade across New Hope Road near Thornton, San Joaquin County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 4-114.3. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the road now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding four percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 crossing signals (General Order No. 75-B) equipped with reflectorized "2 TRACKS" and "STOP ON RED SIGNAL" signs. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be

extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
