ORDER GRANTING CALIFORNIA INDEPENDENT
 TELEPHONE ASSOCIATION LEAVE TO INTERVENE

On January 2, 1964, petitioner California Independent Telephone Association filed a petition for leave to intervene in the instant proceeding because the independent telephone companies have rules and regulations on file with the Commission limiting their liability for errors or omissions in telephone directory listings identical with or similar to the rules and regulations of The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company governing its limitation of liability for telephone directory errors and omissions.

Said petitioner states that it proposes to adduce affirmative evidence relative to the rules, regulations, practices and recommendations of the independent telephone companies operating in California pertaining to limitation of liability for telephone directory errors and omissions, and measures taken and proposed to be taken by the independent telephone companies to mitigate damages to their subscribers resulting therefrom.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that petitioner California Independent Telephone Association is granted leave to intervene herein for the purpose

of adducing affirmative evidence relative to the rules, regulations, practices and recommendations of the independent telephone companies operating in California pertaining to limitation of liability for telephone directory errors and omissions, and measures taken and proposed to be taken by the independent telephone companies to mitigate damages to their subscribers resulting therefrom.
