Application of the State of California,
 Department of Public Works, for an order
 authorizing the relocation of an existing
 grade crossing across the tracks of the
 Sacramento Northern Railway, in connection
 with the improvement of State Highway
 III-Yol,Sac-6-C,Sac, between Seventh Street
 in Broderick and Third Street in Sacramento,
 Tower Bridge Grade Crossing No. 8-92.35. } Application No. 45270

O R D E R

State of California, Department of Public Works, is hereby authorized to relocate the crossing of South River Road at grade with tracks of Sacramento Northern Railway (Crossing No. 8-92.35) at Broderick, Yolo County, as described in the application and in accordance with the plan attached thereto. Width of crossing shall be not less than shown in the plan attached to the application with grades of approach not greater than two percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by four Standard No. 8 crossing signals. (General Order No. 75-B).

Construction expense shall be apportioned by agreement between the parties or, if they fail to agree, by further order of the Commission. Maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant. Sacramento Northern Railway shall bear maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless time be

extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authoriza-
tion may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity,
or safety so require. Applicant desires to begin construction as
soon as possible and has requested immediate authorization. The
effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
