## ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By this application, Echo View Estates Water Co., Inc., requested (1) a certificate of public convenience and necessity to construct an extension of its water system in Meyers, El Dorado County, (2) authority to deviate from its main extension rule by financing the main extension through issuance of stock rather than by construction advances furnished by applicant's affiliated subdivider, and (3) authority to issue additional stock to finance the construction of storage facilities.

By letter dated February 27, 1964, the attorney for applicant advised this Commission that (1) the certificate is not required, inasmuch as the new area is contiguous to the existing system, (2) the extension will now be made pursuant to applicant's main extension rule, and (3) the storage facilities will be financed by equity capital in the form of contributed surplus provided by the two sole stockholders. Under these circumstances, applicant requests that the application be dismissed.

IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 46062 is dismissed without prejudice.
