ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Complainant requests that defendant be required to make no charge for certain telephone directory advertising appearing on page 146 of the classified section of the 1962 Western Section Telephone Directory issued by defendant essentially because the telephone number EXbrook 8-7251 was shown in its all-numeral equivalent, 1398-7251.

On October 30, 1963, defendant filed as part of its answer a motion to dismiss the complaint and a motion to strike certain parts of the complaint.

The issues raised in this complaint are substantially the same as those in Cases Nos. 7445, 7449 and 7504. Final decision in said proceedings having been issued, we find that the complaint in Case No. 7679 should be dismissed.
