INTERIM ORDER

Pasadena City Lines, Inc. asks that the requirements of ordering paragraph 4 of Decision No. 65008, dated February 26, 1963, in this proceeding be suspended. Said paragraph states:

"4. Applicant is directed to place in service during each of the three twelve-month periods consecutively following immediately the effective date of this order five new 45-passenger buses, the first group of five buses to be placed in service as soon as possible after said effective date. Applicant shall advise the Commission in writing as each new bus is placed in service."

Applicant states that it has not purchased any of said new buses, the first five of which are required to be obtained by March 18, 1964, and that it does not now have the resources with which to make such purchases.

However, a decision in the matter cannot be reached prior to March 18, 1964; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the requirements of ordering paragraph 4 of Decision No. 65008 in this proceeding are suspended until further

order of the Commission.
