O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to construct a drill track at grade across three streets in the City of Ontario, San Bernardino County, at the locations as described in the application, and in the manner as indicated below.

Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of each crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72 without super-elevation and with tops of rails flush with each roadway. Crossing identifications, their widths and grades of approach shall be as follows:

<u>Street Name</u>	<u>Assigned Crossing Number</u>	<u>Width of Crossing</u>	<u>Maximum Grades of Approach %</u>
Belmont Street	B-521.4-C	40 feet	2
Phillips Street	B-521.5-C	24 feet	3
Campus Avenue	B-521.7-C	40 feet	4

Protection at Belmont Street (Crossing No. B-521.4-C) and Phillips Street (Crossing No. B-521.5-C) shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B), with reflex reflecting sheet material, at each crossing, and protection at Campus Avenue (Crossing

No. B-521.7-C) shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
