ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

By Decision No. 65171 dated April 2, 1963, in this proceeding, Glen E. Whitlock and George A. Prall were granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a public utility warehouseman for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space at Blythe. The decision ordered that, in providing service pursuant to the certificate therein granted, applicants shall within one hundred and twenty days after the effective date of the order establish the authorized service and file with the Commission tariffs in triplicate. The required tariffs were not filed within the aforementioned period, which expired with August 20, 1963.

Subsequently, by letter from the Secretary of the Commission dated October 9, 1963, applicants were placed on notice that, unless the service were established and tariffs filed immediately, the certificate granted by Decision No. 65171 might be revoked pursuant to lawful procedures. The tariffs have not been filed.

Section 489 of the Public Utilities Code requires that warehousemen, among others, shall file with this Commission schedules showing their rates and classifications.

Glen E. Whitlock and George A. Prall having failed to have on file the required tariff schedules, the Commission finds that such failure constitutes good cause for the revocation of the certificate.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a public utility warehouseman granted to Glen E. Whitlock and George A. Prall by Decision No. 65171, dated April 2, 1963, in Application No. 44969 is hereby revoked.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Glen E. Whitlock and George A. Prall or to mail a certified copy thereof to them at their last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon Glen E. Whitlock and George A. Prall or after the above-mentioned mailing to Glen E. Whitlock and George A. Prall, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written request for public hearing, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
