ORDER

Pacific Electric Railway Company is hereby authorized to construct one spur track at grade across 178th Street, in the City of Gardena, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 6RC-14.82.

Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense.

Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width of 30 feet, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding six percent in accordance with plan attached to the application. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with.

Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety, so require.
