In the Matter of the Application of Pacific Electric Railway Company for authority to construct, maintain and operate a spur track at grade, across Dice Road, southerly of Burke Street, in the City of Santa Fe Springs, County of Los Angeles. )

O R D E R

The Pacific Electric Railway Company is hereby authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Dice Road, in the City of Santa Fe Springs, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 6C-14.77-C.

Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72.

Width of the crossing shall be 64 feet and grades of approach not greater than two percent in accordance with plan attached to the application. Protection at the crossing shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B), supplemented by flashing lights on 12' cantilever arms. Backlights should be installed on all signals.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless

time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
