Protection shall be by two existing Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization - l -
