SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 67072, entered today in Case No. 5432, et al., the Commission found that various exception ratings in Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 2 and 5 that are duplicated in Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1 should be canceled and various exception ratings in said tariffs that are common to each other should be canceled and concurrently transferred to Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1.

That decision also found that, in order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution, Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5 should be amended by separate order.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5 (Appendix "A" of Decision No. 32504, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective May 16, 1964, the revised pages attached hereto and listed in Appendix A, also attached hereto, which pages and appendix by this reference are made a part hereof. C. 5+35 (Pet. 5+) - gl

- 2. Tariff publications authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order, and may be made effective on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff pages incorporated in this order.
- 3. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the exception ratings authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the exception ratings published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing the long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

4. In all other respects said Decision No. 32504, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
