OPINION AND ORDER

A Commission staff member having determined, after exami-
nation and appraisal as required in Section 5135 of the Public
Utilities Code, that applicant is not qualified for a household
goods carrier permit, the matter was set for hearing at Los Angeles
on April 2, 1964, before Examiner Chiesa.

The evidence shows and we find that on January 2, 1964,
applicant Clyde L. Chambers failed to pass the prescribed written
examination; that on January 23, 1964, said applicant failed to
pass a second written examination; that Clyde L. Chambers appeared
at the hearing and was given an opportunity to present evidence of
his qualifications for a household goods carrier permit; that he
failed to present evidence qualifying for such permit, and that

applicant does not possess the required knowledge and ability to engage in business as a household goods carrier.

IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 46182 is denied.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
