O R D E R

City of Los Angeles is hereby authorized to construct Perrino Place at grade across a spur track and three tracks connecting the Union Pacific Railroad Company's main line with the Butte Street lead, in the City of Los Angeles, County of Los Angeles at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 3-1.3-C.

Attached to the application, is a copy of an agreement between the Union Pacific Railroad Company and Soto and Washington Industrial Development Company in which it is agreed that said Development Company will reimburse the Railroad for all of the Railroad's costs in connection with the opening of the proposed crossing.

The costs of installing the grade crossing and the protection, are assessed to the Railroad. The Railroad shall also bear the maintenance cost of the crossing between lines two feet outside of rails at the spur track, the middle track and the two most northerly parallel tracks, including the area between the latter two tracks. Maintenance costs of the crossing approaches outside of said lines shall be borne by the applicant. ✓

Width of the crossing shall be 50 feet and grades of approach not greater than two percent in accordance with plan

attached to the application. Construction at the crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection at the spur track shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B), with reflex reflecting sheet material and protection at the three connecting tracks shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised ~~within one year unless time be~~ extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
