SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 66871 in this proceeding this Commission on February 25, 1964, authorized the City of Glendale to construct Grandview Avenue at grade across a drill track of the Southern Pacific Company. The Southern Pacific Company has advised by letter dated February 26, 1964, that although only one drill track existed at the point of the proposed crossing at the time Application No. 45859 was filed, the Southern Pacific Company intends to add a spur track at this location prior to the construction by the City of Glendale of the new Grandview Avenue. The Southern Pacific Company suggests that provision in the Commission's decision be made for the crossing over the two tracks rather than the one drill track. The City of Glendale has no objection to this change in plans.

Good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that the first paragraph of Decision No. 66871 which reads as follows:

"The City of Glendale is hereby authorized to construct Grandview Avenue at grade across the drill track of the Southern Pacific Company at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. B-475.2-C in the City of Glendale, County of Los Angeles."

is amended to read as follows:

"The City of Glendale is hereby authorized to construct

Grandview Avenue at grade across the drill track and a spur track of the Southern Pacific Company at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. B-475.2-C in the City of Glendale, County of Los Angeles."

In all other respects, Decision No. 66871 is in full force and effect. The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
