ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to construct an additional track at grade across San Timoteo Canyon Road in the County of Riverside, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. B-554.9. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, and of a width of 24 feet and with grades of approach not exceeding four percent, in accordance with plan attached to the application. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B) supplemented with automatic crossing gates.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.
