SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 67122, entered today in Case No. 5432,  
et al., the Commission found that the description applicable to the  
exception ratings on synthetic plastic sheets in Exception Ratings  
Tariff No. 1 and Minimum Rate Tariff No. 1-B should be revised.

That decision also found that, in order to avoid duplica-  
tion of tariff distribution, Minimum Rate Tariff No. 1-B should be  
amended by separate order.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 1-B (Appendix B of Decision  
No. 65834, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating  
therein, to become effective May 30, 1964, Second Revised Page 35  
attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. Tariff publications required to be made by common  
carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not  
earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order on

not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and the public and shall be made effective not later than May 30, 1964.

3. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the exception ratings authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the exception ratings published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing the long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

4. In all other respects said Decision No. 65834, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
