ORDER REVOKING CERTIFICATE OF
 PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY
 AND AUTHORITY TO ISSUE STOCK

By Decision No. 61128, dated November 23, 1960, Santa Tomas Water Co. was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to construct and operate a public utility water system in Tract 10036 near Santa Maria, Santa Barbara County, and authority to issue stock.

Santa Tomas Water Co., by letter dated July 25, 1963, stated "We have informally notified the Commission, in connection with annual report, and other matters, that Santa Tomas Water Co. is inactive, has no assets, no consumers, no operations."

Investigation by the Commission staff shows that no water system has been installed and that the utility is not operating. The Commission finds that applicant has failed to construct and operate a water system pursuant to the certificate granted to it and concludes that the authorizations contained in Decision No. 61128 should be revoked; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that all authority granted to Santa Tomas Water Co., by Decision No. 61128, dated November 23, 1960, in Application No. 42529, is hereby revoked.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Santa Tomas Water Co., or to mail a certified copy thereof to it at its last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the 30th day after such service upon Santa Tomas Water Co. or after the above mailing to Santa Tomas Water Co., as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission written response to this order requesting public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
