ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to construct one additional spur track at grade across Race Street in the City of San Jose and in the unincorporated portion of the County of Santa Clara at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. L-47.9. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway.

Interim protection shall be by the one existing Standard No. 3 wigwag.signal and one Standard No. 1 crossing sign. Within 12 months of the effective date of this order the protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B).

Construction expense shall be apportioned by agreement between the parties, or if they fail to agree, by further order of the Commission.

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Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The applicant states the industry is in need of immediate service to avoid expensive delay in the operation of its warehouse.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
