## SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Distance Table No. 5 consists of two parts designated Part 1 and Part 2 which were served with and by reference made a part of the order in Decision No. 66578 dated January 7, 1964, in this proceeding.

It has come to the Commission's attention that certain oversights occurred in the preparation of Part 1.<sup>1</sup> The necessary corrections will be made.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Distance Table No. 5 issued and served with Decision No. 66578 is hereby amended by Supplement No. 1 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, effective June 6, 1964.

References to Bakersfield and North Sacramento were omitted from Rule 2(c) and a word was omitted from Rule 3(b); two mileage basing point locations were misstated; and two omissions occurred in the index of points.

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2. In all other respects said Decision No. 66578 shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
