SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Ordering paragraph 4 of Decision No. 64611, dated December 4, 1962, in this proceeding, requires Dominguez Water Corporation (Dominguez) to negotiate with Southern California Water Company (Southern) regarding terms upon which a main extension may be transferred to Southern when Southern commences service to the area served by the extension. Dominguez is also required to report the status of such negotiations monthly until further order of the Commission.

By letter dated March 30, 1964, Dominguez has transmitted four copies of an agreement between Dominguez and Southern by which the transfer will be effected.

The Commission finds that it will not be adverse to the public interest for Dominguez and Southern to enter into and carry out the terms and conditions of said agreement and that there will be no further need for periodic reports on the status of negotiations; therefore:

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Dominguez Water Corporation and Southern California Water Company are authorized to carry out the terms and conditions of

their agreement dated March 30, 1964 involving the transfer of water facilities in South Broadway Street north of Victoria Street, Gardena.

2. Dominguez Water Corporation is relieved from filing additional reports in response to ordering paragraph 4 of Decision No. 64611.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
