ORDER GRANTING INTERIM RELIEF

MARJORIE and MICHAEL AIELLO of 4115 New York Avenue, La Crescenta, California, doing business as the Brite Spot located at 6380 Foothill Boulevard, Tujunga, California, having filed a verified complaint alleging in substance that complainants were subscribers and users of telephone service furnished by defendant under number FL-3-9948 located at 6380 Foothill Boulevard, Tujunga, California; that on or about August 25, 1963, the telephone facilities of complainants were removed and disconnected by the defendant pursuant to instructions from the Los Angeles Police Department; that complainants have not used and do not now intend to use said telephone facilities as instrumentalities to violate the law nor in aiding or abetting such violation; that complainants have made demand upon defendant to have said telephone facilities restored, but defendant has refused and does now still refuse to do so; that complainants have suffered and will continue to suffer great hardship if deprived of said telephone facilities; that the activities complained about were engaged in by Michael Aiello, complainant's husband, and that Marjorie Aiello, complainant, has not at any time engaged in any illegal or improper activities; that complainants are both gainfully employed as owners and operators of the Brite Spot, a bar, and said telephone facilities are needed

in connection with the conduct of complainants' business and supervision of children at home; that complainant seeks restoration of said telephone facilities forthwith; and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the General Telephone Company of California, a corporation, is hereby directed to reconnect and restore telephone service to complainants and to maintain such service pending further Commission order herein, said service to be furnished pursuant to defendant's filed tariff rates and rules applicable thereto. The complaint will be set for hearing before such Commissioner or Examiner, and at such time and place, as may hereafter be designated.

The Secretary is directed as follows:

1. To cause a certified copy of this order, together with a copy of the complaint herein, to be served upon the General Telephone Company of California, a corporation, and said defendant is directed to serve and file its reply within ten (10) days after said service.
2. To cause a copy of this order to be mailed to complainants.
3. To cause appropriate notice of hearing to be mailed to the parties at least ten (10) days prior to the hearing herein.
