O P I N I O N

The Greyhound Lines, Inc., requests authority to conduct Special Operations between Victorville and Apple Valley in San Bernardino County.

It is alleged that Apple Valley, a year-round desert resort area with golfing, tennis and swimming facilities, is located five miles east of Victorville; that applicant is presently authorized to operate regular-route service between Los Angeles, San Bernardino and Victorville over U. S. Highway 66; that a travel agent has requested that a tour to Apple Valley Inn be made available on an individual fare basis; and that the manager of the Apple Valley Inn and numerous other individuals have requested the proposed service.

After consideration the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the application. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. A certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to Greyhound Lines, Inc., authorizing the establishment and

operation of service as a passenger stage corporation, as that term is defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code, for the transportation of passengers and baggage between the points and over the routes set forth in Original Page 64-B, attached hereto, as an extension and enlargement of, consolidation with, and subject to all the limitations and restrictions set forth in the certificate granted by Decision No. 55893 and in particular subject to the provisions set forth in Section 3 of Appendix A thereof.

2. Appendix A of Decision No. 55893 is hereby amended by incorporating Original Page 64-B, attached hereto. ✓

3. In providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, applicant shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:

- (a) Within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted.
- (b) Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file in the Commission's office in triplicate tariffs and timetables satisfactory to the Commission.
- (c) The tariff and timetable filings shall be made effective not earlier than ten days after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and the public, and the effective date of the tariff and timetable filings shall be concurrent with the establishment of the service herein authorized.
- (d) The tariff and timetable filings made pursuant to this order shall comply with the regulations governing the construction and filing of tariffs and timetables set forth in the Commission's General Orders Nos. 79 and 98.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
