OPINION AND ORDER

IML Freight, Inc., presently rendering service as a high-  
way common carrier requests that its certificated and permitted  
authority be amended to reflect a change in corporate name from  
Interstate Motor Lines, Inc.

A certified copy of the Articles of Amendment to the  
Articles of Incorporation is attached to the application. No change  
of control or management has been effectuated by the change of  
corporate name. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. All certificates of public convenience and necessity and  
permits issued by this Commission and held in the name of Interstate  
Motor Lines, Inc., are hereby amended by changing the corporate  
name to IML Freight, Inc.

2. After the effective date hereof applicant shall amend its  
tariffs presently on file with the Commission to reflect the change  
in corporate name.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
