ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

The certificate of public convenience and necessity acquired by G & G Trucking Company has been suspended since February 11, 1963, for failure to have on file requisite evidence of liability insurance.¹ The tariffs of this carrier were canceled by its publishing agent effective October 21, 1963.² The carrier was placed on notice by letter dated September 10, 1963, from the Secretary of the Commission, that should it fail to maintain tariffs in effect its highway common carrier operative right would be subject to suspension or revocation, pursuant to lawful procedures.

¹ The certificate authorizes service as a highway common carrier for the transportation of specified commodities between a defined Los Angeles Drayage Area, on the one hand, and Oakland and San Francisco, on the other hand.

² The tariffs are Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Scope of Operations and Participating Carrier Tariff No. 100, Cal.P.U.C. No. 3, Exception Sheet No. 1-A, Cal.P.U.C. No. 18, and Distance Table No. 4 and Local, Joint and Proportional Freight Tariff No. 18-B, Cal.P.U.C. Nos. 15 and 17 (Agent J. L. Beeler series), respectively.

G & G Trucking Company having failed to have on file the required evidence of liability insurance and the required tariffs, and the Commission being of the opinion and finding that such continued failures constitute good cause for the revocation of the certificate,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier acquired by G & G Trucking Company, a corporation, by Decision No. 55529 dated September 10, 1957, as amended by Decision No. 61547 dated February 21, 1961, in Application No. 39345 is hereby revoked.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon G & G Trucking Company or to mail a certified copy thereof to it at its last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon G & G Trucking Company or after the above mailing to G & G Trucking Company, as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written request for public hearing, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
