OPINION AND ORDER

The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company having requested authority to establish the Agoura and Malibu Lake special rate areas within the Canoga Park exchange in accordance with Exhibits A, B, and C attached to the application, and to furnish urban grades of service at rates set forth in Exhibit D as follows:

and it appearing that granting the application should result in improved service in the public interest; therefore,

The Commission finds that a public hearing is not necessary and that such increases in rates and charges as will result are justified and that, for the future, present rates, insofar as they differ from those herein prescribed, would be unjust and unreasonable upon the establishment of the Agoura special rate area and the Malibu Lake special rate area.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. After the effective date of this order and on or before June 1, 1965, applicant is authorized to file with this Commission in conformance with General Order No. 96-A, tariff schedules revised to show the Agoura special rate area within the Canoga Park exchange with a boundary substantially as set forth in Exhibits A and B attached to the application and the Malibu Lake special rate area within the Canoga Park exchange with a boundary substantially as set forth in Exhibits A and C attached to the application and rates for service within the said special rate areas as set forth in Exhibit D attached to the application, and after not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, to make said rates effective for service coincident with establishment of the said special rate areas.

2. Applicant is authorized to withdraw suburban telephone service within the proposed Agoura and Malibu Lake special rate areas upon establishment of such special rate areas.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
