ORDER AMENDING DECISION NO. 65501

Jay Griffith having requested that the fine of \$1,500 imposed upon him by Decision No. 65501 be canceled, the Commission having considered such request, and good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED as follows:

1. The statement in the second paragraph on Sheet 4 of Decision No. 65501 that "respondent should be required to pay a fine of \$1,500" is hereby deleted and amended to read that "respondent's operating authority should be revoked."

2. Ordering paragraph number 1 on Sheet 4 of Decision No. 65501 is amended to provide:

"1. Radial Highway Common Carrier Permit No. 25-221 is hereby revoked."

The Secretary of the Commission is directed to cause personal service of this order to be made upon respondent. The effective date of this order and Decision No. 65501 shall be five (5) days after the completion of such service.
