OPINION AND ORDER

Consumers Transportation Corporation requests that its certificated authority to operate as a petroleum irregular route carrier be suspended until January 1, 1965.

Applicant alleges that certain of its better customers have secured their own fleets of trucks and have discontinued the use of applicant's services and that the resulting financial loss makes it necessary for applicant to suspend operations until additional accounts may be secured.

After consideration the Commission finds that the proposed suspension would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The operating authority granted by Decision No. 44392, dated June 20, 1950, is hereby suspended until January 1, 1965.
2. All effective tariff schedules of Consumers Transportation Corporation as a petroleum irregular route carrier are hereby

suspended until January 1, 1965. Suspension supplements to tariff schedules so suspended are not required and shall not be filed.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
