O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to construct two spur tracks at grade upon and across the easterly half of Alameda Street and one yard track across Eighth Street, in the City of Los Angeles, Los Angeles County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as Crossings No. BG-484.36-C, BG-484.44-C and BG-484.54-C, respectively.

Applicant shall bear the entire construction expense of each crossing. Construction of each crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two percent in accordance with plan attached to the application.

Protection at each Alameda Street crossing (Crossing No. BG-484.36-C and BG-484.44-C) shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (General Order No. 75-B) with reflex reflecting sheet material and protection at Eighth Street (Crossing No. BG-484.54-C) shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) with reflex reflecting sheet material.

Upon completion of Crossing No. BG-484.44-C, the spur track portion of the existing Crossing No. BG-484.4 shall be abandoned and removed.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
