OPINION

A member of the Commission staff having determined, after examination and appraisal as provided by Section 5135 of the Public Utilities Code, that applicant was not qualified, the matter was set for hearing.

A public hearing was held in the above-entitled matter at San Francisco, on March 12, 1964, before Examiner Power.

Applicant now has no permits.

It appeared at the public hearing that applicant was not capable of rating shipments when distance tables and mileage rates were used. He does, however, appear capable of handling shipments of used household goods if his permit were limited to hauls of less than 50 constructive miles to which the hourly rates in Item No. 330 of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 4-B can be applied.

Upon consideration of the application and examination, and the evidence of qualification presented at the hearing, the Commission finds that applicant possesses sufficient knowledge, ability,

integrity, financial resources and responsibility to perform the services of a household goods carrier as set forth in the following order.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that, on the effective date of this decision, the Secretary of the Commission is directed to cause Household Goods Carrier Permit No. 49-2126 to be issued to John T. McGuigan, an individual, inserting therein conditions and restrictions limiting applicant's operation to movements of 50 constructive miles or less.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
