O R D E R

The County of San Diego is hereby authorized to widen and improve the existing Plaza Street (Crossing No. 2-241.8) at grade across the track of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, at the location described in the application, in Solana Beach, San Diego County.

Width of crossing shall be 50 feet in accordance with plans attached to the application, and grades of approach not greater than six percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B) supplemented with automatic crossing gates.

Construction and maintenance costs shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the costs by further order.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization

may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
