In the Matter of the Application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing the construction at grade of a side track across Firestone Boulevard and 92nd Street, between railroad stations of Firestone Park and South Gate, in the County of Los Angeles, State of California.

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to construct a side track at grade across Firestone Boulevard (State Highway 174-B) and across Southern Avenue-92nd Street, near South Gate, in Los Angeles County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as portions of Crossings No. BG-489.5 and BG-489.8, respectively. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense.

Width of Crossing No. BG-489.5 shall be 76 feet and Crossing No. BG-489.8, 56 feet and grades of approach not greater than two percent and four percent, respectively, in accordance with plan attached to the application. Construction at each crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection at Crossing No. BG-489.5 shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals with similar flashing lights on cantilever arms and at Crossing No. BG-489.8 by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-3).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authoriza-

tion shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
