ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to construct a drill track at grade across Batavia Street in the City of Orange, Orange County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. BM-516.15=C.

Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense.

Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, and of a width of 64 feet and with grades of approach not exceeding two percent in accordance with plan attached to the application. Protection shall be by four Standard No. 6 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B). Backlights may be omitted from the signals in the median.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant declares that the warehouse and plant for the industry to be served is expected to be completed by July 1, 1964 and

industry desires immediate rail service. For that reason, waiver of the twenty-day period is requested.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
