ORDER SUSPENDING OPERATIVE RIGHT

Terminal Storage Corporation, a corporation, possesses a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a public utility warehouseman for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space at Coleta, California.

The Commission received a copy of a cancellation notice dated January 9, 1964, addressed to the warehouseman whereby Jack L. Dawson, Agent, notified it that its participation in California Warehouse Tariff Bureau Warehouse Tariff No. 28-A, Cal.P.U.C. No. 193, would be canceled effective April 15, 1964.

Subsequently by letter from the Secretary of the Commission, dated January 15, 1964, Terminal Storage Corporation, was placed on notice that its certificate would be subject to suspension or revocation, pursuant to lawful procedures, should it fail to maintain a tariff in effect. The publishing agent filed with this Commission a tariff revision canceling the participation of Terminal Storage Corporation from the tariff effective April 15, 1964. No substitute tariff has been filed by the warehouseman.

Section 489 of the Public Utilities Code requires that warehousemen, among others, file with this Commission schedules showing their rates and classifications.

The required tariff not being on file and the Commission being of the opinion and finding that such failure constitutes good cause for the suspension of this warehouseman's certificate,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a public utility warehouseman granted to Terminal Storage Corporation by Decision No. 64698 dated December 20, 1962, in Application No. 44944 is hereby suspended pending further order.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Terminal Storage Corporation or to mail a certified copy thereof to it at its last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after such service or after such mailing, as the case may be, unless before such effective date Terminal Storage Corporation shall have filed with this Commission a written request for public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
