SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

William T. Burrow having requested that he be permitted to pay the fine of \$5,000 imposed upon him by Decision No. 67065 in monthly installments of \$500, the Commission having considered such request, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Ordering paragraph 1 of Decision No. 67065 is amended as follows:

1. William T. Burrow shall pay to this Commission a fine of \$5,000, payable in ten monthly installments of \$500, on or before the twentieth day of each month beginning with the 20th day of June, 1964.

2. In all other respects Decision No. 67065 shall remain in full force and effect.
