OPINION AND ORDER

By this petition California Trucking Association seeks to establish an effective date of September 1, 1964, in lieu of the effective date of July 1, 1964, for the tariff revisions required by Decision No. 67123.¹ The tariff revisions in question relate to Minimum Rate Tariff No. 10 (applicable to cement and related commodities shipped therewith), and provide that the distance rates established by that tariff shall be determined in accordance with the provisions of Distance Table No. 5.

Petitioner states that the anticipated timing upon which the effective date of July 1, 1964, was predicated will not be achieved. According to the petition, common carrier tariffs have been developed, but their finalization and publication must await final action by the Colmission on pending "grandfather" applications. Petitioner states that a reasonable extension until September 1, 1964, as herein requested, may well eliminate unnecessary complications, reduce the need for tariff filing revisions, and simplify the transitions required by the recently revised statutory provisions governing cement transportation.

C. 5440 (Pet 18) - hd *

Petitioner alleges that the proposed extension of time has been made known to shippers and carriers of cement, and their representatives, and petitioner is informed and believes that the extension is generally desired by such parties: Ex parte action is requested. Copies of the petition were mailed to California cement manufacturers. No objection to the granting of the petition has been received.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that petitioner's proposal is justified. A public hearing is not necessary. The petition will be granted. Inasmuch as the suspension period sought by petitioner is insufficient to achieve the desired results, petitioner's proposal will be modified by extending the suspension period to October 1, 1964.²

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 10 (Appendix "A" of Decision No. 44633, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein Supplement No. 1 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. Decision No. 67123 dated April 21, 1964, and Decision No. 67244 dated May 19, 1964, are hereby amended by substituting the date of October 1, 1964, for the date of July 1, 1964, in Ordering Paragraphs 5 and 2 thereof respectively.

The same time extension necessarily will be made in connection with the particular distances established in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 10 by Decision No. 67244 dated May 19, 1964.
