BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of the application of the City of Huron to widen crossing No. BD-280.0 of the Southern Pacific Company at Huron.

Application No. 46494

ORDER

City of Huron is hereby authorized to widen the crossing of Lassen Avenue at grade with tracks of the Southern Pacific Company, Crossing No. BD-280.0 in Huron, Fresno County, as described and substantially as shown in the application. Width of crossing shall be not less than seventy feet and grades of approach not greater than three percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. The branch line track shall be protected by two Standard No. 8 crossing signals (General Order No. 75-B), supplemented with flashing light signals on cantilever arms. The spur tracks shall be protected by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflexreflective sheet material. Construction expense shall be apportioned by agreement between the parties or, if they fail to agree, by further order of the Commission. Maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be

extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
