OPINION AND ORDER

Applicant requests permission to revise its present fare zones on its service between San Diego and Lakeside by (1) consolidating zones 10 and 11 into zone 10; (2) consolidating zones 12 and 13 into zone 11; (3) renumbering zone 14 as zone 12; and (4) renumbering zone 15 as zone 13. Said zone revisions will not result in an increase in fares nor a reduction of service.

The application is not opposed and the Commission staff recommends that the requested changes be authorized. The Commission finds that the proposed zone revisions are not adverse to the public interest and that the application should be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that San Diego Economy Line, Inc., a corporation, may and it hereby is authorized to revise its zones set forth in Exhibit "A" filed with its application.

Within ninety days after the effective date hereof and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public, applicant shall amend its tariffs and timetables presently on file with this Commission to reflect the authority herein granted.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
