Decision No. 67460

BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Application of the City of Riverside, California, for an order authorizing relocation of a crossing at grade of the Pacific Electric Railway Company tracks located in Magnolia Avenue and the old City Limits, being Crossing No. 6W-7.45 to a new location at Banbury Drive; and for an order formalizing and assigning a crossing number to the existing crossing of the Pacific Electric Railway Company tracks in Magnolia Avenue intersecting Ross Street, and for an order authorizing alteration of said Ross Street crossing. (amended title)

O R D E R

The City of Riverside is hereby authorized to construct Ross Street and Banbury Drive at grade across the Corona Branch of the Pacific Electric Railway Company at the locations described in the application, as amended, to be identified as Crossing Nos. 6W-6.85 and 6W-7.44, respectively, in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside. Upon the completion of Crossing No. 6W-7.44 and its being open to public travel, the existing crossing identified as Cross Over at City Limits (Crossing No. 6W-7.45) shall be physically abandoned and closed.

Ross Street (Crossing No. 6W-6.85) and Banbury Drive (Crossing No. 6W-7.44) shall be 80 feet and 84 feet in width, respectively, with grades of approach not greater than two percent, in accordance with plans attached to the application. Construction of each crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of

General Order No. 72. Protection at each crossing shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) with reflex-reflecting sheet material.

Applicant shall bear the entire construction expense, also maintenance cost of each crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The Pacific Electric Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost of each crossing between such lines.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
