SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Ordering paragraph 2.a. of Decision No. 66945, dated March 17, 1964, provides that Jensen Water Company shall serve not more than 100 customers until it has demonstrated to the Commission the adequacy of its water supply and has replaced all facilities not meeting the requirements of General Order No. 103.

By letter dated June 1, 1964, applicant has reported that its water supply is now adequate and that its system now meets the requirements of the general order. A member of the Commission staff has verified applicant's statements.

The Commission finds that the restriction in ordering paragraph 2.a. limiting the number of customers that may be served is no longer necessary and concludes that it should be lifted. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the restriction against serving more than 100 customers, imposed by ordering paragraph 2.a. of Decision No. 66945, is hereby rescinded.

In all other respects Decision No. 66945 shall remain in full force and effect.
