# OPINION

By this application, as amended, authority is sought to add a passenger stage service for special events between points in East Kern and North Los Angeles Counties, namely: Ridgecrest, China Lake, California City, Boron, North Edwards, Mojave, Rosamond, Lancaster, Palmdale, on the one hand, and points in South Los Angeles and Orange Counties, namely: Hollywood Bowl, Dodger Stadium, Los Angeles Coliseum, Pacific Ocean Park, Disneyland, Knotts Berry Farm, Pasadena Rose Parade, Hollywood Park and Santa Anita Race Track, on the other hand.

Applicant proposes to restrict its operation to passengers originating in East Kern and North Los Angeles Counties on a roundtrip basis only.

Service will be subject to a 24-hour advance reservation, along described routes, and fares will depend on distances from points of origin as set forth in the exhibits filed with the application and amendment thereto.

The application is not opposed, and has been favorably considered by the Commission staff.

The Commission finds that public convenience and necessity

For operating convenience only, motor vehicles may be turned at termini and intermediate points, in either direction, at intersections of streets or by operating around a block contiguous to such intersections or in accordance with local traffic rules.

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- 5. On-call service shall be operated as required for 28 or more persons on Routes Nos. 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11 and for 24 or more persons on Routes Nos. 12 and 13.

- 7. Where route descriptions are given in one direction they apply to operations in either direction unless otherwise directed.
